

The Friends of St. Anthony (FOSA) is the Outreach Program of St. Anthony of Padua Parish in Woburn.

Through their outreach programs, FOSA also help the homeless in Boston. A project led by Michael Millette, along with the members of the Father Leo Lynch Youth Ministry Program, items are collected and distributed in the China Town, Boston Veteran's Home, and Boston's Mass and Cass areas.

Michael Millette distributes items to the homeless in Boston on a weekly basis. But on **Mother's Day**, the FOSA seek non-perishable snacks, water, feminine products, toiletries and gently used clothing, pocketbooks, \$5.00 gift cards (McDonald's, Burger King, Wendy's and Dunkin Donuts) and tote bags for distribution to the females who find themselves homeless.
