What is it? Pope Francis has started this Synod to hear from various members of the Catholic Church community on how the Church can listen better on all levels. In order to make improvements in the Church, we first must establish the best method to listen to the greatest number of people. For now we will **not** be discussing the issues within the church, the focus will be on listening.

What does that mean for the Woburn Catholic Collaborative? We will participate in several structured listening sessions where parishioners will meet for moderated discussions of the Synod questions about how the Church can listen better to its people and how we can best listen to each other.
